Project Ideas

- Create a newspaper report about the discovery of Skara Brae
- Write a visitor's guide to Stonehenge
- Design a Stone Age outfit
- Create a chronological timeline of the dates and events which took place during the Stone Age
- Create a PowerPoint presentation about a Stone Age animal of your choice.
- Have a go at fishing
- Grow your own vegetables
- Make some Stone Age bread or fruit stew
- Create a Stone Age tool or weapon
- Make a model of Stonehenge
- Research a Stone Age animal of your choice and create an information poster with your findings
- Sketch a Stone Age animal
- Go on a rock hunt; what can you find?
