Dear Parents/Carers,

Please find below the list of home learning tasks for Spring 1. This term, we begin our new topic: 'Road Trip to Europe'. The children are encouraged to choose the project ideas they would like to create and how they wish to present them to the rest of the class. This half term's project needs to be completed and returned by **Monday 7th February**. Once returned, the children have the opportunity to share their learning with the rest of their class. If your child needs any paper or other resources that school can provide, please encourage them to ask their class teacher.

Project Ideas

- Find about different languages spoken across Europe. Record your findings in an interesting way.
- If you could go anywhere in Europe, where would it be? How would you get there? Create an itinerary for your dream destination.
- Build a model of a famous European landmark - ancient or modern.
- Make a fact file about the UK containing interesting information linked to Geography.
- Compare Rotherham with another European town or city. What are the similarities and differences? Record your findings imaginatively.
- Research the different mountains/rivers in the British Isles. Record their heights/lengths in ascending order (smallest to largest).
- Find out about traditional European foods. Create a 5 course menu to share your findings.

Weekly Tasks

As well as the projects, there are reading assignments on Reading Eggs to complete. After reading each chapter, children will face quiz questions on what they have read.

As a school, children are encouraged to read at home at least four times a week and practise their times tables on Times Tables Rockstars. Children are expected to have a quick recall of facts up to 12x12 and knowing these will really benefit them during maths sessions, where the emphasis will be on speed.
