Year 4 Multiplication Check 2022 Parents' Meeting

Dear Year 4 Parents/Carers

You may be aware that, back in 2019, the Government announced a new 'test' for year 4 children called the 'Multiplication Tables Check'. This was scheduled to begin from June 2020 although, due to the pandemic, was postponed in June 2020 and again in June 2021. However, we can confirm that this year's year 4 children will be the first to officially complete the check, which will take place during a three week window in June this year.

By the end of year 4, the National Curriculum states that children are expected to be able to instantly recall multiplication facts up to 12 x 12, as well as the related division facts. The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall these facts, something that is essential for future success in mathematics. It will also help us as a school to identify if your child may need additional support.
