Below are some home learning project ideas related to this term's topic, 'Ancient Civilisations.' This term we will focus on the Ancient Egyptians, encouraging the children to become investigative learners, develop their enquiry skills, independence and creativity. This half term's project needs to be completed and returned to school by **Monday, 22nd May**. If your child needs any paper, or other resources that school can provide, please encourage them to ask their teacher.

Project Ideas

- Create a tourist leaflet about Egypt
- Make a Pharaoh Headdress
- Turn a paper plate into a Cleopatra's necklace
- Use a pringle can to create a papier mache canopic Jar
- Construct your own pyramid
- Write some instructions on how to mummify a person
- Make a quiz about Ancient Egypt that the class can do using the Kahoot website
- Using technology, create a word cloud of some exciting, Ancient Egypt topic vocabulary
- Try some Egyptian food recipes, take images of you cooking or baking and bring your product in to share with your class
- Research famous landmarks in Egypt then locate them on a map
- Find out about the Egyptian Gods and take some notes to share with the class, then design your own Egyptian God

Weekly Tasks

As well as these project ideas, children are encouraged to read at home four times a week (this can include Reading Eggs) and practise their times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars. Children are expected to have a quick recall of facts of the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables and knowing these will really benefit them during maths sessions, where the emphasis will be on speed.
