- Research and design an Ancient Temple. Think about the different materials you can use.

Weekly Tasks

As well as these project ideas, children are encouraged to read at home at least three times a week and practise their times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars. Children are expected to have a quick recall of facts up to 12 x 12 and knowing these will really benefit them during maths sessions, where the emphasis will be on speed.
