AUTUMN TERM EXTRA-CURRICULAR CLUBS

Dear Parent/Carer,

On the reverse of this letter are the clubs that will be on offer during the autumn term of the next academic year.

Signing up to autumn-term clubs

Children return to school on Tuesday 5th September; autumn term clubs will start the week commencing **Monday 11th September**. All clubs will run from **15:00-16:00** and your child must be collected by an adult **promptly at 16:00**. Only children in years 5 or 6 with written permission will be able to walk home.

Please complete the attached form and get your child to hand it to their class teacher by Friday 14th July. Year 2 should hand it into their current Year 2 teacher by this date. Places for each club are limited and will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis.

Once places are allocated

If your child has been allocated a place, you will receive an email to confirm this on **Monday 4th September**. All after-school clubs cost **£3.00 per session**, payable on ParentPay. Due to bank holidays and teacher training days, the number of club weeks may vary from club to club. You can find out how many weeks your child's club is running for on Parent Pay.

Due to continued interest, some clubs have a waiting list. Please ensure that payment for the full amount is received by the end of the first week back (**Friday 8th September**). This will confirm your child's place. If payment isn't received, it will be assumed that your child will **not** be taking up their place at the club; this place will then be reallocated to someone on the waiting list. Please contact the school office if you have any questions about this.

Behaviour Expectations

We encourage all of our children to engage in the extra-curricular activities on offer as they help to develop their interests and confidence as well as to build new friendships. Our staff work hard to share their enthusiasm and knowledge during the range of clubs on offer and, as a result, they are an enjoyable experience for all. So that this continues, your child is expected to display our **Three Rules** (Ready, Respectful, Safe) and our **Sitwell Seven Values** during all extra-curricular activities, just like they are expected to during the school day. Staff will continue to follow our behaviour policy to promote positive behaviour, and all behaviour which falls short of expectations will be addressed in the first instance with the relevant child(ren). If this behaviour persists, parents/carers will then be contacted, where next steps will be decided. This may result in a last opportunity for your child to positively engage in the club, although could also result in your child being unable to attend in future.
