Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check 2023 Parents' Meeting**Thursday 28th September - 14:30-14:50 or 15:20-15:40 - school hall**

Dear Year 4 Parents/Carers,

You may be aware that, back in 2019, the government announced a new 'test' for year 4 children called the 'Multiplication Tables Check'. **Your year 4 child will sit this check near the end of this academic year** (during a two-week window commencing Monday 3rd June).

By the end of year 4, the National Curriculum states that children are expected to be able to instantly recall multiplication facts up to 12 x 12, as well as the related division facts. The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can **fluently** recall these facts, something that is essential for future success in mathematics. It will also help us as a school to identify if your child may need additional support.

We invite you to attend our parents' meeting on the date above in order to provide further information about the Multiplication Check and how you can continue to support your child at home with learning their tables. The meeting will not take long, and there are two times that you can choose from: **14:30-14:50 or 15:20-15:40**. You do not need to attend both - we are running the same meeting twice so that as many of you can attend as possible.
