On the reverse of this letter are the clubs that will be on offer during the spring term.

Signing up to spring-term clubs

Children return to school on **Monday, 8th January** and spring term clubs will start on this day too. All clubs will run from **15:00-16:00** and your child must be collected by an adult **promptly at 16:00**. Only children in years 5 or 6 with written permission will be able to walk home.

Please complete the attached form and get your child to hand it to their class teacher by Friday 8th December. Places for each club are limited and will be allocated on a **first come, first serve basis**.

Once places are allocated

If your child has been allocated a place, the payment item will appear on ParentPay by **Wednesday 13th December**. All after-school clubs cost **£3.00 per session**. Due to bank holidays and teacher training days, the number of club weeks may vary from club to club. You can find out how many weeks your child's club is running for on ParentPay.

Due to continued interest, some clubs have a waiting list. Please ensure that payment for the full amount is received by **Monday 1st January**. This will confirm your child's place. If payment isn't received, it will be assumed that your child will **not** be taking up their place at the club; this place will then be reallocated to someone on the waiting list. Please contact the school office if you have any questions about this.

Behaviour Expectations

We encourage all of our children to engage in the extra-curricular activities on offer as they help to develop their interests and confidence as well as to build new friendships. Our staff work hard to share their enthusiasm and knowledge during the range of clubs on offer and, as a result, they are an enjoyable experience for all. So that this
